**men K1:** seniors, juniors, youth 15/16 years, masters  
**men C1:** seniors, juniors, youth 15/16 years, masters  
**women K1:** seniors, juniors, youth 15/16 years, masters

**Entries:**

The competition will be conducted on "open" form. German National team, Foreign National teams and Clubs may enter Canoe Marathon of Markleeberg 2007. There is no limitation of numbers of crews.

Nominal entries on the valid forms complete with competitors' list should be sent before June 15, 2007 to the organizers address.

Entries after June 15<sup>th</sup> are possible but will cost 2,50 Euro extra per race

Portages run:	12,50 Euro per competitor
7000m open:	5,00 Euro per competitor
7000m children:	3,50 Euro per competitor

21km:	12,50 Euro per competitor
21km+portages run (both events)	20,00 Euro per competitor

Winner of medals at World-, European- or German Championships of Marathon, white water or flat water in 2006 and 2007 will not pay any fees. Some financial assistance is planned for international clubs and teams. Please contact the organisers for details.

**Things to know**

Canoe and Kayaks must comply with the ICF marathon rules with an exception for the tourist classes. Each craft must have adequate buoyancy / bulk heads to ensure craft does not sink.

In the "Open race" are tourist boats and racing boats allowed.

**Boat control:** Individuals can check their craft length and weight however it is not obligatory. NB: If in doubt check it out!

**Team Leaders meeting:** All course and technical details will be finalised at the "Team leader meeting" Please ensure you are represented otherwise you might miss out on important information.

**Transport and Accommodation:** Each participant is responsible for their own transport and accommodation. The organizer can assist in finding accommodation and board. Please contact the organiser for further details.

**Insurance:** All official participants of the Canoe Festival are strongly advised to take out a medical insurance policy prior to their departure to the event.

**Medical care:** The following medical services are available for all official participants of the Canoe Festival: doctor on duty, hospital and clinic assistance. A medical centre will operate at the competition venue with ambulance and first aid. The costs above regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by your medical insurance policy; the Organizing Committee is not responsible to cover your expenses in connection with hospital treatment, dental treatment or any other medical treatment.
