General information of Réunion Island.

Réunion Island is a French island located in the Indian Ocean, between Mauritius and Malagasy. Réunion Island is a part of Europe in the southern hemisphere. It is famous for its waterfalls, its mountains (3090m), its creole food, and the beauty of the ocean; It is a paradise for all paddlers. You can practice slalom, ocean racing, and white-water activities. Regarding general data, there are 860,000 inhabitants and the average temperature is 30° C (February/at sea level),

General information of the venue.

The white-water artificial stadium is built on the bank of Sainte Suzanne river. The design of the white-water channels includes a system of complementary channels and mechanical conveyor belts which enable paddlers to return to their starting point without having to leave their boats. The slalom course's specific features are the following: - Length: 350 m - Drop: 8 m - Flow: 10 m3/s - Course features: concrete bottom, banks and modular obstacles - Spectators capacity: 2,000 people If you want to use the course before the ICF Cup for training camps, the SEVI team can book training slots directly at : https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1pFT2J5fsLwaYM-Q3QVHxu-r43WWt2S67SISV-3xAHaI/edit?usp=sharing
